Next week with your adult, during your home learning, you might like to:

- Do some research about the key features of reptiles. Then draw 4 different reptiles and write about the key features.
- Design and colour your own animal. Will your animal have scales, fur, 4 limbs or more, wings, lay eggs, be warm or cold blooded. Be as imaginative as you like. Then write about your animal. You can use key phrases to help you. Also, don't forget to use capital letters, full stops and some exclamation marks. Some of you can use some simple adjectives eg 'sharp claws'.
- In Maths, you can start to find ½ and ¼ of different shapes. Then you can begin to find ½ of a given amount eg What is ½ of 8? Then you can begin to find ¼ of a given amount. Eg What is ¼ of 8? Or if you are still working on measuring how long, tall or short an object is, please continue with that.
- At any time, you can start keeping a journal, telling some of the things you are doing. Write everything in your book and I look forward to reading and seeing all the wonderful learning you are doing at home.
